SUBJECT: MOWW Policy on Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC) & JROTC Awards

TO: All ROTC and JROTC Organizations

The Military Order of the World Wars (MOWW) proudly supports Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC) and JROTC organizations, and their respective award programs. This support results from long-standing relationships between MOWW and the United States Armed Forces.

This support includes MOWW providing an embossed certificate, a presentation folder and a ribbon at no cost to ROTC/JROTC units requesting these awards. Full -sized medals (which most units order) are available at a nominal cost. ROTC units have Gold, Silver and Bronze award levels, and JROTC has a single award level. Allow two weeks for delivery.

ROTC/JROTC UNITS PREVIOUSLY SUPPORTED BY MOWW CHAPTERS

If your unit was previously supported by a local MOWW chapter, please continue coordinating with that chapter for your annual ROTC and JROTC award support. This includes arranging for a MOWW chapter representative to present MOWW medals, ribbons and/or certificates at your award ceremony.

If a member of MOWW is not available to make the presentation, any active duty, Reserve, National Guard or retired federally commissioned or warrant officers may present MOWW award materials. This includes commissioned and warrant officers of the US Army, US Navy, US Marine Corps, US Air Force, US Coast Guard, US Public Health Service, and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration.
